Decentralisation at the state level

1st October 2010 - reform of the model of public funding for science comes into force.


State funding of research and development will be executed through two agencies:

1. National Centre for Research and Development
2. National Centre for Science


Role of Ministry - creating policy and strategy, no more funding agency.



Boosting public funds for applied research



Increasing the portion of „difficult” money in the state budget for science



- public funds for research projects distributed on competitive base (payments in bln PLN)
- other public funds (payments in bln PLN)



Priority for commercialisation

2,6 bln EUR contracted in Innovative Economy Operational Programme for 2007-2013 intended to result in commercial products.

Pressure of the Government on research institutions - they have contractual obligations towards Government as regards commercialisation.



Main role of subsidies, lack of effective fiscal instruments

Polish Government is investing approximately 15 bln PLN in applied research (2007-2013).

Main portion of the subsidies directed to public research organisations.

Poor other instruments (eg. fiscal). In 2008 only 50-80 business enterprises benefited from fiscal instruments.
